

# JR Kaga Onsen Station CANBUS Bus Stop Information



## Note to CANBUS Passengers

2021.4.1

- Ticket prices: adult 1-day pass ¥1,100, 2-day pass ¥1,300 / child 1-day pass ¥550, 2-day pass ¥650.
- Admissions are not included in the price of a bus pass.
- Please note that the bus operates only in one direction.
- Seats may not be reserved. If the bus is full you may not be able to board it.
- Passengers can ride all three routes with a single CANBUS ticket.
- Single-trip tickets not available (except for the Komatsu Airport Line).
- The 2-day pass can be used on any two days of a three-day period.
- CANBUS passes available for sale on buses.
- A 1-day pass can be changed to a 2-day pass for a fee (¥500 for adults, ¥200 for children).



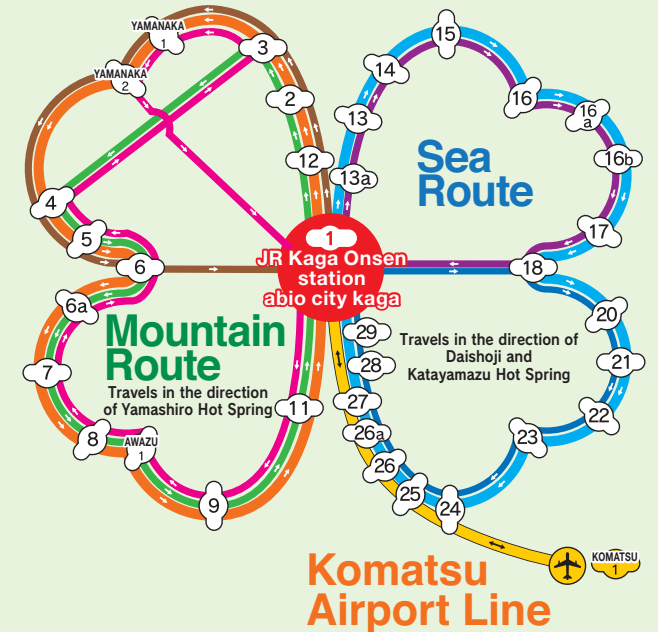

# Kaga Loop Bus CANBUS

The Kaga Loop Bus departing from and returning to the JR Kaga Onsen Station is the most convenient way to visit all the main sightseeing spots around. Passengers are free to hop on and off as much as they want for personalized travel plans. Three bus lines are available: the Mountain Route, the Sea Route and the Komatsu Airport line.

Hands-on lessons to make your own string of prayer beads are popular with visitors.




●Ancient Kutani Kiln Exhibition Center
